

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18)

- All ground outside the inside line of the clubs boundary defined by Black and White markers are Out of Bounds. These include: Boundary fence, Club house, surrounds and machinery shed.
- o Instead of the player returning to the spot of the previous shot in the event of a lost ball or a ball **out of bounds**, the player can take a drop in the nearest spot of the fairway (within two club-lengths of the edge of the fairway), no nearer the hole than where the ball crossed the OB line, with a two-stroke penalty.

Note: The Club has 2 internal Out of Bounds:

- o From the 2/11 Tee, R.H side of the water hazard after the bridge (3/12 General Area)
- o From the 3/12 Tee, L.H side of the trees after the bridge, (4th/13th General Area)

2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR) - (RULE 16)

- o Any area defined by White lines and marked G.U.R. (compulsory relief)
- Sloping banks to roadways on the 1st/10th & 2nd/11th hole
- Stakes trees (compulsory relief)
- o Concrete drain to the right fairway on the 6th hole
- o Bare patches on 1st/10th, 2nd/11th through the green and all other fairway holes
- o Bare patches on greens

3. DROP ZONE RELIEF (RULE 17)

- o 5th/14th hole for balls entering the hazard left of the foot bridge
- o 6th/15th hole for balls entering the hazard beyond the 6th/15th fairway

4. BRIDGES in HAZARDS (RULE 16)

o A players ball coming to rest on a bridge that is within the boundary of a hazard must play the ball as if it was in the hazard.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 16)

Free relief may be taken for:

o Protective screens, seats, sand or rubbish bins, retaining walls, sprinkler heads, formed roads and buggy paths

6. LOOSE IMPEDIMENTS (RULE 15)

o You may remove a loose impediments (stones in bunkers, loose grass, branches and sticks) without penalty anywhere on or off the course, and may do so in any way (such as by using your hand, foot or club).

7. GARDENS (RULE 16)

 All garden and bark areas on the golf course and club house surrounds (that are not out of bounds) qualify for compulsory free relief (nearest point of relief, no nearer to the hole). This EXCLUDES the barked area to the R.H side of the 9th/18th fairway bunker. Un-staked trees do not qualify for relief

8. PREFFERED LIES

o 1st & 10th Hole – The hill from the road to the 100metre marker is preferred lies (rough only). In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

9. PLAYER INFORMATION

- Sand buckets are to be carried and used to fill divots on and off the fairway
- Blue Markers = 150m to the centre of the green.
- Yellow Markers = 100m to the centre of the green.
- Distance measuring devices are allowed on the Golf Course
- o Additional rules can appear on the local rules board outside the Pro Shop. Please review this board prior to teeing off.
